Program Overview:

Dates: Tuesday, May 27th thru Friday, August 8th

Time: 6:30am- 6:00pm

Location: Sunset Elementary Gymnasium

What to bring:

Lunch: Please provide a lunch for your child every day. The Summer Lunch Program will begin June 9th. If your child would like to participate in this program, no lunch is needed. The Summer Lunch Program will end July 25th. After July 25th you will need to be provided a lunch for your child.

Water bottle: Please provide your child with a labeled water bottle for daily use.

Walking shoes: Please provide closed toed shoes that your child can run in.

Daily Schedule:

Our program is designed to offer a balance of engaging activities such as crafts, STEM Projects, outdoor adventures and more. (Attached to the back is the summer schedule)

Swim Days: We will be swimming <u>every Tuesday and Thursday</u>. We will be walking to the Municipal Pool on these days. (If any swim days are canceled it will be posted on our Clubhouse Facebook Page)

Field Trips: Field Trips are <u>every Wednesday</u>. Field trip days sometimes require us to leave at 8:00 am or earlier; please make sure you have your child dropped off on time. We want to experience every destination to the fullest potential and want to arrive on time. We will no longer wait for participants who are

"on the way" or arrive late. <u>IF YOUR CHILD RUNS AWAY FROM THE GROUP</u> WHILE ON A FIELD TRIP THEY WILL BE SUSPENDED FROM FIELD TRIPS.

Money: Students may <u>ONLY</u> bring spending money for concessions at the Municipal Pool. It should be turned into a Clubhouse staff member upon arrival. The staff member will then put the money in a Ziploc bag and write the child's name on the bag. The bag will be put into a Money Bag to be distributed at the proper time. We are not responsible for students' money if not given to staff. We do not guarantee children will be able to use this money every week.

Behavior Policy:

Our program's philosophy on discipline is based on respect for the child's self-esteem, setting reasonable limits and consequences and encouraging increased self-discipline. The staff will work with the child and cooperate with the parents to resolve any problems that may arise.

Corrective Action Plan C.A.P:

NRC Clubhouse **staff will fill out a C.A.P. Form when a child has exhibited** <u>Disrespectful behaviors and actions for example fighting, physical violence, and cursing at individuals, **providing an unsafe environment** through words, <u>attempting to leave facilities etc.</u></u>

All warnings will be communicated with a parent or guardian:

- The first course of action for a child is a verbal warning.
- The second course of action for a child is a written warning

Once they have received all of these warnings the next course of action:

• Suspension based upon the severity of the situation. Students are suspended from NRC Clubhouse until a specified timeframe.

The final action:

• Termination from NRC Clubhouse programs.

If a child's behavior consistently disrupts the flow of the program, physically or emotionally harms others and otherwise conflicts with the program rules and guidelines, a form will be written. In the event the problem persists after all reasonable attempts have been made, the child will be dismissed from the program.

IF YOUR CHILD RUNS AWAY FROM THE GROUP THEY WILL BE SENT HOME FOR THE DAY. We are UNABLE to provide ONE-ON-ONE care and have to consider the safety of other children under our supervision.

Payments: We use ProCare, an online billing system. Payments can be made anytime with a card using the ProCare app or website. Cash and check

payments can be made at the front desk of Newton Recreation Commission. Card payments can also be made at the front desk or by calling (316) 283-7330, Monday – Friday 8:00am - 4:00pm.

Guidelines for Personal items:

Size limitation: Any personal items brought by your child must fit comfortably into a standard size backpack. (As well as swimming gear)

Staff is NOT responsible for personal items!

Restrictions: Due to having many disruption and conflicts NO POKEMON CARDS! NO BOARD GAMES! NO BAKUGAN! NO MAKEUP! NO ELECTROINCS!

If your child decides to bring any personal items, it is important to remind them of their responsibility for these belongings. While summer clubhouse staff will make every effort to assist in locating lost or broken items and addressing any related situation, it's important to understand that bringing personal items carries inherent risk. We will not guarantee the recovery of lost, stolen or broken items. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation in enduring a safe and enjoyable experience for all participants.
